# 1. Government of India Post Matric Scholarship (GOI)-SC

## Eligibility:-

- 1) The parents/Guardian annual income shall be less than or equal to Rs. **2,50,000.**
- 2) Student category shall belong to Scheduled caste or Nav boudha
- 3) Student shall belong to resident of Maharashtra
- 4) Student should be passes SSC/equivalent Matric.

## Documents Required

- Income Certificate (Provided by Tahesildar)
- Cast Certificate.
- Mark sheet for last appeared examination
- Mark sheet for SSC or HSC
- Father death Certificate(if required)
- Gap & Self Declaration(if required)
- Hostel Certificate (if required)
- Husband Income Certificate (If girl is married)

## 2. Post Matric Tution fee and exam fee (Freeship)-SC

### Eligibility:-

- The parents / Guardian annual income above Rs. 2,50,000.to unlimited.
- Student category should be Scheduled caste or Neo bouddhist
- Student should be resident of Maharashtra
- Student should be passes SSC/equivalent Matric.

### Documents Required

- Income Certificate (Provided by Tahesildar).
- Cast Certificate.
- Cast Validity Certificate
- Mark sheet for last appeared examination
- Mark sheet for SSC or HSC
- Father date Certificate(if required)
- Hostel Certificate (if required)
- CAP round allotment letter



# 1. Post Matric Scholarship Scheme (GOI-ST)

## Eligibility

- Applicable for ST only
  - \* If Family **Income**  $\leq$  **2,50,000**, he will get the scholarship
  - \* Minimum 10th Pass
  - \* Back to back drop for 2 years he/she will not be allowed to fill form.

## Documents Required

- - Income Certificate (Provided by Tahesildar).
  - Cast Certificate.
  - Cast Validity Certificate
  - Mark sheet for last appeared examination
  - Mark sheet for SSC or HSC
  - Father date Certificate(if required)
  - Hostel Certificate (if required)
  - CAP round allotment letter

## 2. Tuition Fee & Exam Fee for Tribal Students ( Freeship-ST).

### Eligibility

- Applicable for ST only
  - \* Family annual income limit is **RS. > 2,50,000**

Renewal Policy : The student have to pass the previous year examination

- \* If student fails in any year then he is not paid the scholarship for that particular year

### Documents Required

- 1. Caste Certificate
- 2. Previous year's marksheet
- 3. Caste Validity



# 1. Rajarshi Chhatrapati Shahu Maharaj Shikshan Shulkh Shishyavrutti Yojna(Open)

## Eligibility

- a) Applicant should have Nationality of India.
- b) Candidate should be Domicile of Maharashtra State.
- c) Applicant should be "Bonafide Student of Institute" and admitted for Professional and Technical course (Diploma / Graduation / Post Graduation Degree) as mentioned in GR
- d) Deemed University and Private university is not applicable
- e) Candidate should be admitted through Centralized Admission Process (CAP).
- f) Applicant should not avail any other scholarship/stipend.
- g) For current Academic Year, Only 2 child from family are allowed for benefit of scheme.
- h) The Total Annual Income of Family / Guardian should not be more than **8 Lakhs**.
- i) Minimum 50 % attendance in previous semester (Exception for fresh admitted in College).
- j) During course duration, candidate should not have a gap of 2 or more than 2 years.

## Documents Required

- a) Mark sheet of 10th (S.S.C) & Onwards.
- b) Domicile Certificate of Maharashtra State.
- c) Family Annual Income certificate
- d) Undertaking "In current year, not more than 2 beneficiary from family".
- e) CAP Related document.
- f) Proof of Biometric attendance (Interface UIDAI).



# 2. Dr. Panjabrao Deshmukh

## Vasatigrub Nirvah Bhatta Yojna.

### Benefits

- a) For child of Registered Labor / Alpabudharak (Marginal Land Holder).
  - For institute in MMRDA / PMRDA / Aurangabad City / Nagpur City- Rs.30,000/- for 10 months.
  - For institute in other area Rs.20,000/- for 10 months.
- b) For Annual Family income up to 8 Lakhs.
  - For institute in MMRDA / PMRDA/ Aurangabad City / Nagpur City- Rs.10,000/- for 10 months.
  - For Institute in other area Rs.8,000/- for 10 months.

### Eligibility

- a) Applicant should have Nationality of India.
- b) Candidate should be Domicile of Maharashtra State.
- c) The Total Annual Income of Family / Guardian should not be **more than 8 Lakhs.**

### Documents Required

- a) Mark sheet of 10th (S.S.C) & Onwards.
- b) Domicile Certificate of Maharashtra State.
- c) Register Labor Certificate / Alpabudharak (Marginal Land Holder) Certificate ( In case of not a child of Alpabudharak or Registered Labour then family Annual Income Certificate ).
- d) Undertaking "In current year, not more than 2 beneficiary from family".
- e) CAP Related document.
- f) Hosteller documents ( In case of private hostel or Paying Guest, Agreement with owner will be required.

# 3. Scholarship Scheme for State Minority Communities Pursuing Higher Professional Education Post

## Overview

- The objective of the Scheme is to provide financial assistance to the meritorious students belonging to Minority Communities ( Muslim , Buddhist, Christian , Sikh , Parsi , Jain & Jews Community ) to enable them to pursue Professional and Technical Courses.

Benefits

## Eligibility

- a) Applicant should have Nationality of India.
- b) Candidate should be Domicile of Maharashtra State.
- c) Candidates should have pass SSC from Maharashtra State.
- d) Applicant should be "Bonafide Student of Institute" and admitted for Professional and Technical course (Diploma / Graduation / Post Graduation Degree) as mentioned in GR
- e) Candidate should be admitted through Centralized Admission Process (CAP) / Institute Level.
- f) Applicant should not avail any other scholarship/stipend.
- g) The Total Annual Income of Family / Guardian should not be more **than 8 Lakhs.**

## Documents Required

- a) Educational Certificate – S.S.C.(10th) & onwards.
- b) Income and Minority declaration – Affidavit on Non-Judicial Stamp Paper or Income certificate from the employer, if any. School leaving certificate can also be considered as Proof of Minority ) or Self Declaration.
- c) Proof of permanent residence: - Copy of Domicile Certificate/Election Card etc.
- d) For Renewal of Scholarship: - Income declaration and Mark Sheet of previous examination.



# 1. Post Matric Scholarship to VJNT Students.

## Eligibility

- 1) The parents/Guardians annual Income should be less than or equal to **Rs.1.00 Lac.**
- 2) Applicant should be belongs to VJNT category.
- 3) Applicants must be residents of Maharashtra.

## Renewal Policy

- 1) Applicant have to pass the previous year examination.

## Documents Required

1. **Caste certificate** - should be issued by competent authority(Issued by Govt. of Maharashtra) This certificate considered as Proof of Resident.
2. **Income certificate / Income Declaration** - should be issued by competent authority
3. **Caste Validity Certificate** – (Mandatory for Professional Degree courses, Professional Post Graduate. For Non Professional courses caste validity is not mandatory)
4. **HSC or SSC marksheet or last examination marksheet.**
5. **Gap certificate** - Not mandatory but in case of gap it is mandatory.
6. If applicable **father/Guardians death certificate.**
7. **Ration Card** for identify number of children in family.
8. **Leaving Certificate**
9. **Declaration certificate of parents/guardians** about number of children beneficiaries.

# 2. Tuition Fees and Examination Fees to VJNT

## Students

### Eligibility

- 1) Applicant must be taking post matric education.
- 2) Applicant should belong to VJNT category.
- 3) Parent's annual income should be less than or equal to **8.00 Lacs.**
- 4) Applicants must be residents of Maharashtra.

### Renewal Policy

- 1) Applicant need to provide previous years marksheet.
- 2) At a time Applicant can apply freeship for only one educational course and it will be applicable till he/she completes that educational course in specified time.
- 3) Applicant cannot take freeship for more than 2 professional courses.
- 4) If due to any medical condition or due to any unforeseeable event the Applicant cannot appear in the annual examination, the head master of the college can approve or certify that if the Applicant would have appeared in the annual examination, he would have been able to pass the examination. This will be only allowed if the head of the institution is satisfied by the submission of medical proof or any other required sufficient proof that the Applicant presents to the college.
